26. Prosecco Extra Dry, Serena 1881

Veneto, Italy Bright aromas of pears apples and peaches are followed by more of the same on the palate. Gentle easy-going sparkler from north eastern Italy. Bottle **£31.00**

28. Champagne Drappier Carte d'Or Brut

Champagne, France A Pinot Noir-based champagne of style and finesse, Carte d'Or offers delicate aromas of white peach, quince and a touch of spice. The dry, elegant palate shows an impressive degree of concentration, along with fine bubbles and a long, crisp finish. Bottle **²85.00**

29. Laurent-Perrier Rosé

Champagne, France Fresh and zingy with a fine mousse and soft red fruit flavours. Bottle **£105.00**

16 Morandé Pionero **Merlot Reserva**

Valle Central, Chile This beautifully balanced Merlot combines smooth ripe plum and raspberry fruit with some savoury cinnamon spice and a neat medium-bodied texture, finishing on notes of dark chocolate.

Visconti della Rocca Primitivo 17.

Puglia, Italy Intense, fruity Primitivo full of jammy plum fruit and savoury spice. Smooth-textured with a lick of vanilla on the finish.

18. Deakin Estate Shiraz

Victoria. Australia Good punchy Shiraz aromas of mulberry and plum, supported by hints of vanilla and coffee oak. The palate is juicy, spicy and satisfying, with a rounded finish.

Promesa Rioja Crianza 19.

Rioja, Spain

A classic style of Rioja, with strawberry, blackberry and rhubarb fruit flavours taking on a vanilla and cocoa smoothness during twelve months in oak barrels.

20. Côtes-du-Rhône Samorëns Rouge, Ferraton Rhône, France

Medium to full-bodied, the bright, fresh cherry and berry fruit is followed by a savoury earthy note and lifted by floral, peppery aromas. The tannins are silky and well rounded and the finish is fresh.

Bodega La Flor Malbec, 21. Pulenta

Mendoza, Argentina Fresh raspberry aromas complement Malbec's trademark floral violet notes on the nose. The palate is round and soft, with gentle tannins to complement the fresh red and black fruit flavours and just a hint of vanilla, liquorice and spice on the finish.

12. Terre del Noce Pinot Grigio Rosé

Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy Jam-packed with the ripe strawberry and raspberry fruit you would expect from this variety, but with far more intensity and structure than the norm. The finish is long, lingering and clean, with a fine acidity. 125ml **°5.50 /** 250ml **°10.00 /** Bottle **°27.00**

13. Conde Valdemar Rioja Rosé

Rioja, Spain Clear, pale salmon colour, with delicate raspberry fruit and the elegant herbal finish of Garnacha, overlayed with floral notes from the Mazuelo.

8. Regaleali Bianco, Tasca

Sicily, Italy Delicately fruity nose with apple, peach and pink grapefruit notes. The palate is quite intense and crisp, with plenty of fresh fruit flavours. 125ml ***7.70 /** 250ml ***13.80 /** Btl ***39.00**

9. Xisto Ilimitado Douro Branco, Luis Seabra

Douro, Portugal A bright, lifted palate shows flavours of freshly picked nectarines, peaches and pears, all against a complex backdrop of wet stones, chalk. Graceful and powerful all at once, with a salty, savoury complexity and a compellingly chewy texture which runs through to the lengthy finish. 125ml ***8.95 /** 250ml ***15.75 /** Bottle ***45.00**

10. Chablis, Domaine Jean-Marc Brocard

Burgundy, France The nose is precise, pure and mineral, with additional notes of citrus. The palate is classic Chablis: structured, crisp and delicious, with flavours echoing the nose. 125ml **°10.10 /** 250ml **17.90 /** Bottle **°51.00**

11. Bourgogne Chardonnay Prestige, Henri de Villamont

Burgundy, France Richly vibrant white burgundy, offering characteristic aromas of red apple and grilled nuts, and a creamy texture on the palate cut with some citrus freshness. Lovely balance and length complete this fine expression of the Henri de Villamont style.

14. **Château La Coste Rosé** (Organic) *Provence, France* A vibrant and delicate rosé, with fresh summer berries and melon apparent on the nose. Nectarine and citrus lead the palate with some textural richness permitting this wine to work well with food, as well as on its own.

23. Campofiorin, IGT Rosso del Veronese, Masi

Veneto, Italy Attractive, aromatic nose dominated by cherries and spice. Well-balanced, full-bodied palate with notes of ripe red fruit, cherry liqueur and blueberries. Long aftertaste with hints of vanilla and cocoa. 125ml **°9.30 /** 250ml **°15.90 /** Bottle **°45.00**

24. Château Ksara Rouge,

Château Ksara

Bekaa Valley, Lebanon Up front there are bold raspberry and blackcurrant flavours that give way to leathery, spicy notes. There is a touch of vanilla from the oak and the rich, mellow tannins are complemented by refreshing acidity on the finish.

25. Ridge Geyserville
